## Therapeutic Hypothermia for Neonates with Hypoxic Ischemic Encephalopathy

**Sandra Juul, MD, PhD** is Professor of Pediatrics and Associate Division Head for Scholarship and Research at the University of Washington. Dr. Juul is a neonatologist and researcher of HIE and therapeutic hypothermia. Her research interests are focused in two primary areas: Factors which impact normal neurodevelopment and possible neuroprotective therapies for brain injury.
