




**Directions from I-5 Northbound:** Take Exit 105 and bear left for the State Capitol/City Center exit. Cross over Interstate 5 and keep in the left lane on 14th Ave SE. through the roundabout (Jefferson St) and under the tunnel 0.4 mi to Capitol Blvd. Continue across Capitol Blvd to the Capitol Building on Sid Snyder Ave SW (14th Ave becomes Sid Snyder Ave).


- 1610 Water Street SW

- Parking is strictly enforced.

# campus visitor parking



- Pay for street parking from 8 am to 5 pm.
- Purple meters are \$1/hour,2 hours max, and acceptcredit/debit cards and coins.
- Green meters are \$0.60/ hour, 3 hours max, and take coins only.
- Gray meters are \$0.50/hour,
  9 hours max, and take coins only.
- Push the button before adding money for 15 minutes free.
- Orange on the map shows 1 and 2 hour free parking zones (one time per day)

### Dash shuttle

- The Dash shuttle is FREE.
- It runs every 15 minutes from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Parking is allowed at the Farmers Market (north end of Capitol Way) January through March in the green-striped stalls for \$1.50/hour.
- The Farmers Market is closed during this time of year.
- The Dash shuttle services Visitor Parking at Maple Park (Maple Park Avenue & Jefferson Street). From I-5, take a left at the Jefferson roundabout and then a right onto Maple Park Avenue. The lot is immediately on your right. Cost is \$1.50/hour.
- The Dash shuttle also goes to the Professional Arts Lot (11th Avenue & Washington Street). Cost is \$1.50/hour.
