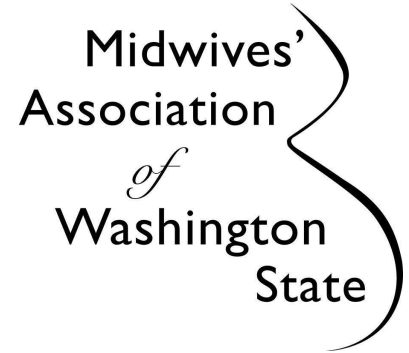


Schedule, Links & Resources for MAWS' Lobby Day 2020

How Do I...?

- Figure out where to Park?

 - Link to the parking lots and Dash shuttle service for the Capitol Campus
 - www.leg.wa.gov/legislature/Pages/Parking.aspx
 - Amber (our Lobbyist's house where we will meet for our briefing and snacks at 8am) is about a block and a half from the Visitor's Center, lot #1 on the map. North and South Diagonal parking (#2) is right on campus, too, if you can find a spot in this pay lot.
 - The Farmer's Market (#8 on the map) is closed this time of year, so the lot is pretty empty. If parking is full everywhere else then this is a good bet. This is also pay parking. The Dash shuttle comes every 12 minutes.
 - Parking along the Deschutes Parkway, #9 on the map, is free. You just need enough time to walk or take the bus up to the campus. The #9 is written on the map at a park called Marathon Park. From Marathon Park, there is a walking path around the south side of Capitol Lake which connects to a switchback path up the hill ("Heritage Park hillside trail") to the Campus.  - Parking meter spots requiring coins may be found near the United Churches of Olympia which is on 11th and Capitol Way. Leave time (~15 min) to walk to the morning briefing.

 - LEG = Legislative Building (the large stately looking one with a breast on top)
 - INB = Irv Newhouse Senate office building
 - JAC = John A. Cherburg Senate office building
 - JLOB = John L. O'Brien House office building

- Figure out if the Rep I am seeing has already voted for/sponsored our bills or issues?

For specifics, view votes under the “roll calls” link on the bill page:

- (2019) Voted for the [Governor’s Operating Budget](#) which included the budget proviso to cap our licensing fees and the Doulas for All Initiative
- (2018) [HB2016](#) - Ensuring access to volunteer midwifery & doula services for incarcerated pregnant & laboring persons
- (2017) [SB5299/HB1474](#) - Promoting healthy outcomes for pregnant persons and infants [SB5032/HB 1116](#) - Implementing family and medical leave insurance
- (2015) [HB1080/SB5010](#) While this bill didn’t pass either chamber, money was included in the budget for the program restoring funding to the WA State Health Professionals Loan Repayment program which includes LMs. 9 LM sites were approved for Loan Repayment.
- (2014) [HB 1773](#) Unanimous in the Senate; House roll call (only 5 dissent): <http://app.leg.wa.gov/far/RollCall?rollCallId=39926&bienId=22>
- (2013) Voted for our budget proviso as part of 2013-15 Operating Budget ([SB 5034](#)).

- (2012) [HB 2186](#) (which allows LMs to collaborate with RNs) had unanimous support in the House & Senate.
- (2011) [HB 1176/SB 5071](#) (which gave LMs access to HEAL-WA and thus to a wealth of evidence) had unanimous support in the House & Senate.
